The vehicle was captured in a still from the dashcam video posted by twitter user @mcslaw. There's no evidence of whether the woman was injured. NYPD's arrest of a tow truck driver, who, in the middle of an emergency, drove away with a traffic jam's worth of cars attached to his truck, has divided the Twitter community. On Sunday, NYPD's 31st Precinct tweeted about a towing truck blocking traffic on the No. 3 local on the BQE for "at least two hours," without mentioning the driver's name. The incident in the East Williamsburg neighborhood, which has been known for all sorts of bad things in the past, appeared to be one of the few instances in which the city's police did not interact with a tow truck driver. As of Tuesday, the tweet had over 200 retweets and close to 300 likes. It was retweeted by the NYPD's official Twitter account and NYPDchief. On Monday, NYPD

responded to the viral tweet by asking for the driver's name. The tweet included the driver's license number and the driver's information, as well as contact information for NYPD. “I would ask that you please refrain from posting any additional information, but if you do feel comfortable doing so, please send that information to us at the following address: NYPD 31st Precinct, Criminal Investigation Bureau, Lieutenant Mark Carfano ” said Sgt. Sylvia Antigua, NYPD’s media relations office, in an email to Patch. The 30-year-old driver has been identified as Louis Lapopolo, a driver for Wyckoff Towing. The owner of the vehicle pictured in the Twitter post, Alaina Kuefner, did not want to comment on the incident, but did tell Patch she’d called the NYPD’s 311 line about the vehicle’s removal and discovered the towing truck had disappeared. “I didn't get answers when I called 311 and I was pretty upset, so I was trying to do some research,” she said.

Kuefner posted on Twitter that, after searching for the truck and calling the NYPD's tips hotline, she discovered that Lapopolo and a dispatcher had the vehicle towed 2d92ce491b
